(4) Summary of the applicant's research achievements and educational activities.

(5) An essay on the applicant's future research plan and educational policy. It should be within two pages in total.

(6) List of any funds or research grants that the applicant acquired

(7) Contact information of two reference persons (name, affiliation, telephone

number, and e-mail address)
